## Christ's Love and The Resurrection of Lazarus - A Great Cloud of Witnesses (Part 1 &2)

**SPS:** To gain a deeper appreciation for and increase our faith in the resurrected Jesus Christ's direct and personal interest and involvement in your daily life.

## Foundation Scriptures – The Great Cloud of Witnesses

- 1. Acts 1:4-11 God has given us His Holy Spirit
- 2. Hebrews 13:1-9 God the Father and Jesus Christ have incredible expectations of us.
- 3. Hebrews 12:1-11 We have access to the "great cloud of witnesses"
- 4. **Hebrews 4:14–16** We have a Great High Priest who understands

## John 11:1-4 - The Resurrection of Lazarus

- 1. We are dealing with someone who is gravely sick
- 2. His name is Lazarus...he is from Bethany
- 3. He has a sister by the name of Mary
- 4. He has a sister by the name of Martha
- 5. Lazarus was loved by Jesus Christ
- 6. Jesus Christ is not in Bethany when he hears of Lazarus' sickness.

There are times when:

- A. Jesus Christ was nearby: John 5:6–9
- B. The requestor for intercessory prayer was with Jesus Christ, but the person who was sick was somewhere else: **John 4:46–51**
- C. A third party came to request healing for the one sick: Luke 7:2–10
- 7. Jesus Christ already knew that Lazarus was sick
- 8. Jesus Christ knew that his sickness was not unto death
  - A. Christ may choose not to give the answer to our question: Matthew 21:24–27
  - B. Christ may choose to answer with, NO!: Mark 10:35-40
  - C. Christ may choose to answer with, WAIT...and I will heal you in this physical life: **2 Corinthians** 12:7–9
  - D. Christ may choose to answer with, WAIT...and I will heal you in the Resurrection: John 11:4
  - E. Christ may choose to answer with, YES...immediately!: Luke 8:43-48
- 9. Jesus Christ knew that Lazarus sickness was for the glory of His Father: John 11:4
- 10. Jesus Christ knew that his sickness was so the Son of God might be glorified through it: John 11:4
  - A. Sometimes, Jesus Christ does reveal the greater purpose for our sicknesses as he did for Paul: **2**Corinthians 12:7–10
  - B. Sometimes, an infirmity may last for decades before the answer is revealed: John 9:1–7
  - C. Sometimes, God allows life itself to cease before the answer is revealed: John 11:6-7
