1	<u>Point #58:</u>	<u>Human Deity</u>	Those who orchestrated, supported, and taught the heinous act child sacrifice. Those human today that believe they stand in place of God in matters of life and death. In Scripture but are described as serving a Satan-inspired deity	Deuteronomy 12:31 Leviticus 18:21
2	<u>Point #59:</u>	<u>Witchcraft</u>	The practice of manipulating supernatural or spiritual forces to affect outcomes — casting spells, using charms, brewing potions, invoking spirits, or performing rituals	2 Kings 17:17 Exodus 22:18 1 Samuel 15:23
3	<u>Point #60:</u>	<u>Soothsayer</u>	They are primarily about <i>knowing</i> — obtaining hidden information, especially about the future, through supernatural or occult means.	Isaiah 2:6 Micah 5:12
4	<u>Point #61:</u>	<u>Diviner</u>	Involves methods like casting lots, reading entrails (internal organs and intestines of animals and people), or consulting omens (a phenomenon, event, or sign believed to portend or warn of a future occurrence, typically signifying impending good or evil).	Isaiah 3:1–2 Acts 16:16
5	<u>Point #62:</u>	<u>Enchanter</u>	<i>A whisperer; whispering</i> , i.e. prayers uttered in a low voice; incantation, magic, “specially charming serpents”; use of amulets, or superstitious ornaments, commonly gems and precious stones, necklaces, rings, earrings	Isaiah 3:1,3 Genesis 35:4 Jeremiah 8:17 Ecclesiastes 10:11
6	<u>Point #63:</u>	<u>Sorcerer</u>	Sorcery is the practice and use of supernatural powers, often involving rituals, spells, and the summoning of spirits to manipulate natural or occult forces, typically with malevolent intent	Exodus 22:18 Galatians 5:19–21 Acts 8:9–11 Acts 13:6–8 (NIV84)
7	<u>Point #64:</u>	<u>Medium</u>	They claim to communicate with spirits, acting as conduits between the living and the deceased to deliver messages. They utilize extrasensory perception, such as clairvoyance (seeing) or clairaudience (hearing)	Leviticus 19:31 Leviticus 20:6 Isaiah 8:19
8	<u>Point #65:</u>	<u>Spiritist</u>	One who contacts and gains information from a spirit, works with familiar spirits and can call on specific spirits to operate on their behalf. A matter of properly knowing, being wise, hence <i>a prophet, a wizard</i> , always used in a bad sense of false prophets. 9	<u>Point #66:</u>	<u>Necromancer</u>	One who specifically claims to call up the dead!	Deuteronomy 18:10–11
10	<u>Point #67:</u>	<u>Magicians</u>	There is stage magic or illusions: the art of performing tricks and illusions for entertainment, often using clever methods to appear supernatural”. There is mystical and spiritual magic: They delve into the mystical and into spiritism. The indication is that the magicians in the Bible blended the two.	Exodus 7:11–12 Acts 19:19
11	<u>Point #68:</u>	<u>Astrologers</u>	The study of correlations between celestial movements (stars, planets, constellations) and earthly events, interpreting planetary positions at birth to understand personality and life events. It includes 12 zodiac signs (Aries to Pisces), elements (Fire, Earth, Air, Water), and planetary influences, functioning as a tool for self-awareness, fortune-telling, future-telling, and prognostication rather than as a science.	Isaiah 47:13–14 Daniel 2:27–28
11	<u>Point #69:</u>	<u>Dreamer of Dreams</u>	Receive messages from the spirit-world through sleep.	Deuteronomy 13:1–3 Numbers 12:6 Zechariah 10:2
12	<u>Point #70:</u>	<u>Prophets</u>	Typically receive messages from the spirit-world while awake.	Jeremiah 23:28 Jeremiah 23:31–32
